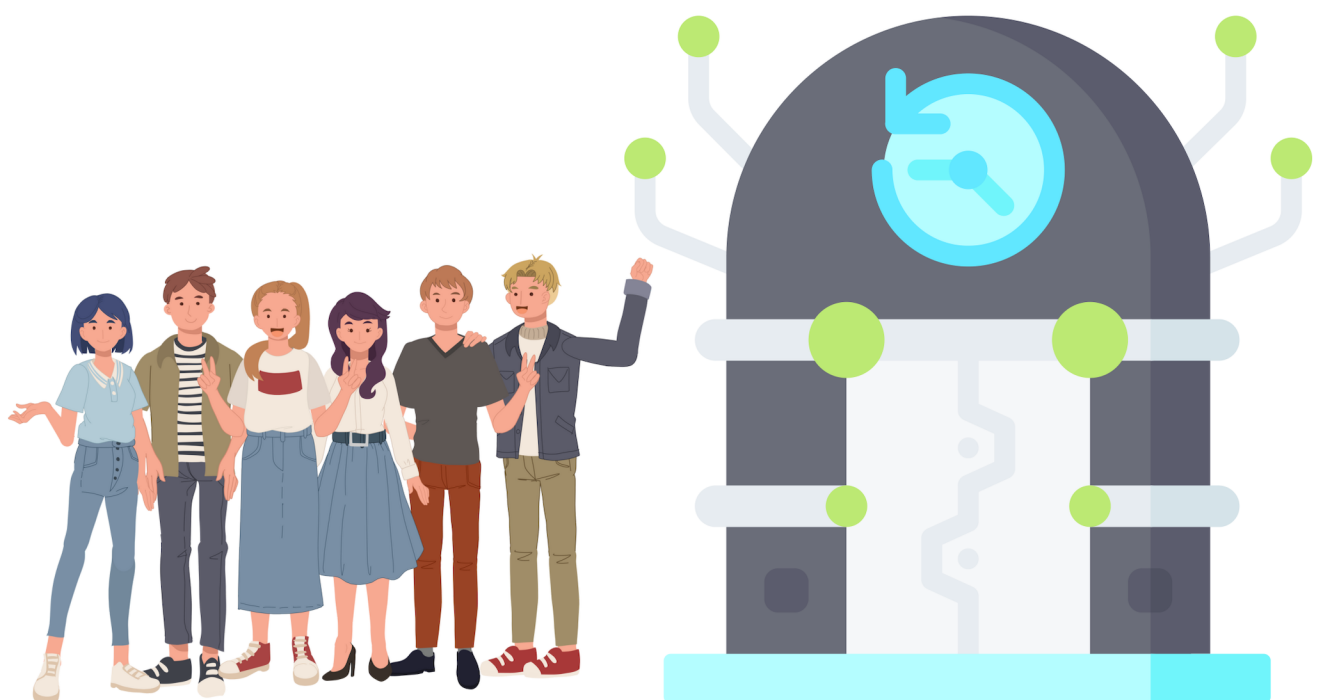
## SIMPLE PAST

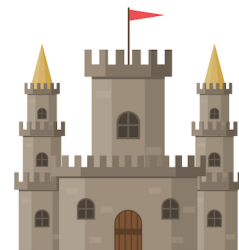
Read the text below about medieval time and answer the following questions.

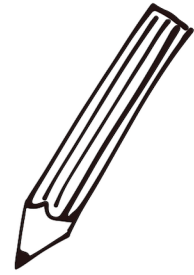
