Targets of the Stadelheim pilot study

Mother-Child-Dyad

- Acquisition and application of voice-movement-based interactivities
- Enhancement of bonding-modalities
- Empathy and adequate perception of the child
- Child's aesthetic & motor development

Mother's self-awareness & skills

- Self-Exploration (e.g., subconscious, behavioural response patterns)
- Self-control (e.g., aggressive impulses, paranoid thoughts, irascibility)
- Stress-management
- Sense-making day-structure lö
- Creativity


