//By Car

Most probably you will get to Eichstätt on the Autobahn A9 (freeway).

Take exit 58 Altmühltal "Kinding/Kipfenberg/Beilngries/Eichstätt". Follow the signs indicating "Eichstätt". Follow the "Spindeltal" and turn right on "Römerstraße".



//By Train

Trains to Eichstätt from bigger cities leave from Nuremberg and Munich. In order to get to Eichstätt city, you need to take the train to "Eichstätt Bahnhof" and then transfer to the train to "Eichstätt Stadt".
