



(Strengthening) Financial Lives of Refugees: Insights from Jordan and Kenia

This session will cover empirical and conceptual findings from the research project “Finance in Displacement (FIND): Exploring and strengthening financial lives of forcibly displaced persons”, a research initiative that aimed to better understand how refugee and asylum-seeking households in urban settings in Jordan manage their livelihoods and financial lives. We learned about their financial coping strategies—saving, borrowing, remitting, insuring—and what helped or hindered these strategies. We uncovered which financial services they used and which were less relevant to their livelihood journeys in displacement. Using the grounded theory approach we arrived at a conceptual framework using financial health which is helpful to identify policy and programmatic interventions to improve the financial lives of refugees. We will also present the five high-level findings that summarise our key conclusions and recommendations.
