Formalities

- How much lead time is required before the start of the processing time (weeks/months)?

Dependent on the preparation of the students. Master's theses usually take four to six weeks, including the exploration of the topic. During this time, a functional outline is created in one to two weeks, leading to the kick-off event. The kick-off event officially registers the master's thesis.

- Deadline(s) for applying for the Bachelor's thesis (date/month):

No deadlines for applying for the bachelor's thesis.

- Deadline(s) for applying for a Master's thesis (date/month)

- Documents to be submitted when applying for a thesis (e.g. Topic expose (scope), ToR, CV, etc.):

The exposé is approximately 3 pages, including an outline draft, and is often created after the preliminary discussion. Documents to be submitted for the application include a questionnaire with the student's name, courses taken at the chair, and grades. Some parts of this information may be left open.
