Formalities

- How much lead time is required before the start of the processing time (weeks/months)?

A preparatory meeting in which fundamental questions are discussed is mandatory: it is clarified whether the requirements for a thesis are met (see below), what ideas the student has, etc. There is no specific timeframe.

- Deadline(s) for applying for the Bachelor's thesis (date/month):

There is no deadline for the application. During the preliminary discussion, students indicate their desired processing period. This request is almost always accommodated. Topic assignment occurs at the beginning of the processing period.

- Deadline(s) for applying for a Master's thesis (date/month)

There is no deadline for the application. During the preliminary discussion, students indicate their desired processing period. This request is almost always accommodated. Topic assignment occurs at the beginning of the processing period.

- Documents to be submitted when applying for a thesis (e.g. Topic expose (scope), ToR, CV, etc.):
