Formalities

- How much lead time is required before the start of the processing time (weeks/months)?

The lead time depends on the type of thesis (BA/MA) and the topic (possibly involving a practice partner). Accordingly, it can take between four and approx. six weeks.

- Deadline(s) for applying for a Bachelor's thesis (date/month):

 - Winter semester: until July 15
 - Summer semester: until February 01

- Deadline(s) for applying for a Master's thesis (date/month):

 - Winter semester: until July 15
 - Summer semester: until February 01
