

Anerkennung für Kultur & Gesellschaft und Wirtschaftssprachen

I. Anerkennung Kultur & Gesellschaft (Bachelor)

Students are expected to supply the following:

- Comprehensive module description including course content, student workload (hours of attendance plus expected preparation time), detailed exam information, credit points
- For language classes the module description **must** include the level of language instruction according to the **C**ommon European Frame of Reference (CEFR).
- Copy of WFI transcript/Flex

Students wishing to receive credit for a language course from abroad/another university who have taken a course in the same language at the WFI/KU: The language level cannot be below the level of the course taken at the WFI/KU.

Modules for Kultur & Gesellschaft can be chosen from the following fields of study:

- History
- Philology
- Archeology
- Law
- Religion
- Anthropology
- Area Studies

- Psychology
- Philosophy
- Politics
- (Applied) linguistics/Languages
- Cultural Studies
- Sociology
- Communication Studies

II. Anerkennung Wirtschaftssprachen Bachelor/Master (Wahlbereich/Wahlpflicht)

Students are expected to supply the following:

- Comprehensive module description including course content, student workload, exam information, credit points, the level of language instruction according to the Common European Frame of Reference (for language classes and Business Communication)
- Copy of WFI transcript

Students wishing to receive credit for a language course from abroad who have taken a course in the same language at the WFI/KU: The language level cannot be below the level of the course taken at the WFI/KU. The minimum level of instruction must be B2 in any business language (CEFR).

Modules can be chosen from the following fields of study:

- Business Languages
- Business Communication Skills (e.g. Presentations, Business Writing, ...)
- Intercultural Communication

Note: General language classes of any level are **not** accepted as elective modules ("Wahlbereich/Wahlpflicht").
