

Since the summer semester 2018, the WFI Ingolstadt School of Management has been offering the lecture series "Sustainability in China" in cooperation with the Audi Confucius Institute Ingolstadt (Director AKII: Prof. Dr. Peter Augsdörfer) and the Competence Unit Sustainability in China (Director CUSC: Prof. Dr. André Habisch). Due to the high demand and interest, the lecture series is now taking place for the fifth time in a row and provides a comprehensive insight into current developments and changing topics in the field of sustainability in China.

Lectures from various disciplines with professors from Chinese and German universities (Zhejiang University, Beijing International Studies University, Zhongnan University of Economics and Law, Chongqing University, THN Nuremberg) will provide a comprehensive look at exciting topics related to sustainability in China. The programme also includes presentations from Chinese organisations (China Water Risk, China Social Enterprise Certification Center) and the tourism and information technology industries (WildChina, Merck Europe) as well as Bayer China and Eversheds Sutherland.

All speakers will present live on Mondays, so please note the sometimes different start times due to the time difference (please see poster). All presentations will be held in English, via Zoom. After the presentations (duration 60 to 90 min each), the speakers will be available to answer questions.
