
## eduroam configuration macOS

These instructions were created using macOS 12.2.1. Depending on the version of MacOS, the appearance of the System Settings may vary slightly.


## Removing an old profile

If you have previously connected your device to the eduroam network, you should remove the old profile file before setting up eduroam again.


1. On your Mac, navigate to **System Settings** → **Profile**.




As stated initially, different versions of MacOS have different looking settings panels, see the following screenshot taken on an M1 MacBook running macOS Sonoma 14.5 for reference:



If you happen to have a different looking settings panel like or don't have the "Profile" icon sitting where it is shown in the previous screenshot, just type "Profile" in the search bar. It should appear quickly:




2. Select your old eduroam profile and remove it.



## Installing a new profile

 Download the current configuration file from the eduroam website: <a href="https://cat.eduroam.org/?idp=5710">https://cat.eduroam.org/?idp=5710</a>
 Click on the button to download the installation programm:





2. Open the downloaded file: "eduroam-OS\_X-KUEI.mobileconfig". Please note that the naming scheme may have changed in the meantime. As of May 2024 it reads as follows: "eduroam-OS\_X-CUoE-TTLS-PAP.mobileconfig". The procedure remains the same.

A notification about the installation of the profile will be displayed in the top right-hand corner:




## 3. Open System Settings $\rightarrow$ Profile






4. Choose the eduroam profile and click on "Install..."




5. Enter your user ID in the following window:
At "user name" enter your user ID followed by @ku.de - this is important.
Students also enter @ku.de after their user ID, not @stud.ku.de.

Example for a student: sls34343@ku.de Example for an employee: gga34343@ku.de

In the "Passwort" field, enter your password (which you also use for  $\ensuremath{\text{KU.Campus}}$  ).




6. In the following window, enter your system username and system password, then click on "Install":



These are the username and password that you use to log into your iMac or MacBook. If you are unsure of your username, you can confirm it in the **Users & Groups** panel in the **System Preference**:






7. In the next window, confirm the note by clicking on "Install".



8. Lastly, your device will ask for confirmation to make changes. Enter your system username and system password again, then click "**OK**":



9. Your eduroam profile has now been set up, and you can connect to the eduroam network.



You may need to restart your Mac before using eduroam for the first time.
