


# Configuration of eduroam for Android EN

This documentation was created by Android 9 (Samsung). Other versions or customization by other vendors will be slightly different.

If you had previously set up Eduroam on your Android device, simply install the new certificate in the section **install new certificate** and then adjust the configuration under **edit certificate of Eduroam**.

## install new certificate

- download the current configuration file from our website: <https://www.ku.de/rechenzentrum/it-services/netz/wlan/eduroam> open




- enter the current PIN (device PIN)
- specify certificate name "Eduroam-until-2033" is an example of this  
the usage type must be "Wi-Fi"




**edit certificate of Eduroam (this step is only necessary if Eduroam was already set up)**
