

geteduroam App for iOS and Android (EN)

For an easy configuration of eduroam for mobile devices you can use <https://www.geteduroam.app/> .

The geteduroam app replaces the “eduroam CAT” app from Android 11. Up to and including Android 10, we recommend installation via “eduroam CAT”: <https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=uk.ac.swansea.eduroamcat>

Note: Setting up the eduroam configuration only works on the KU campus or at another institution that provides an eduroam network.

1) Download the geteduroam app:




Alternatively, you can search for the geteduroam app in the App Store or Play Store.

2) Open the app, select “Katholische Universität Eichstätt-Ingolstadt” as the institution and then click on “Next”.



3) Enter your user name. It is important to enter “@ku.de” after your user name.
Important: Even if your e-mail address contains a different prefix such as “@stud.ku.de” or “@ext.ku.de”, “@ku.de” will be used for the configuration of eduroam.

Enter the corresponding password of your user ID in the password field and click on “Connect to Network”.



Your device should now automatically connect to the eduroam WLAN network.

You should confirm any queries from the system.
