



DAAD-STIBET scholarship 2024 for international students

In 2024, the KU offers the following funding opportunities for **international students** at the KU who are **professionally suitable and who are in financial need**: **DAAD-STIBET scholarship for international students**.

Funding period: October 01, 2024 - February 28, 2025 (5 months)

This DAAD scholarship is € 450.00 per month (total of € 2,250.00)

The following types of scholarships are available:

- a) Course completion scholarships: (minimum duration: one month, maximum duration: 6 months; can in exceptional cases be extended to 12 months max.) Supports students on their path to achieving a successful degree within one year and helps scholarship holders who are in financial need through no fault of their own to concentrate on their studies and graduation.
- b) Special commitment scholarships: (minimum duration: one month, maximum duration: 12 months; extension possible in exceptional cases) Prerequisite for funding is that the international students and doctoral candidates have performed well, but have also distinguished themselves through outstanding commitment in an international context at their university. The scholarship may not be linked to any return consideration (no services, employment relationships, etc.).
- c) Scholarships for increased equal opportunities: (minimum duration: one month, maximum duration: 24 months) for beneficiaries who experienced special challenges during their studies (e.g. refugees, persons with disabilities or chronic illnesses, persons with special care situations for children and persons in need of care).

Selection criteria:

- Professional suitability (average grade at least 2.3 and better)
- Personal suitability
- You are enrolled in an academic degree program at the KU (Eichstätt campus or Ingolstadt campus) during the funding period.
- Financial hardship
- Voluntary commitment (must be proven)
- Students on the DSH German course with conditional admission as well as free movers
 are excluded from funding. Exchange students can also apply, but priority will be given
 to degree-seeking KU students who are equally eligible for funding.



Application:

Applications must be submitted ONLINE only. Please upload the following documents:

- Current transcript of records; for Master's students in addition: a copy of the Bachelor's certificate
- German or English résumé in table form
- Certificate of enrollment at the KU
- Letter of motivation (German or English, approx. 1 page)
- · Copy of passport or identity card
- If applicable, confirmations of voluntary commitment and documents about your financial needs

In addition, an academic letter of recommendation must be sent directly to the International Office, for the attention of Ms. Jessica Hofmacher, incoming@ku.de.

Application deadline: July 14, 2024

Please note:

There is no entitlement to funding. Applicants may be invited to personal interviews. Applicants will be informed of the selection result in writing (by e-mail). Individual reasons for funding or rejection are not given.

A person in financial need within the meaning of the guidelines is someone who does not exceed the following income limits:

• Gross income per year:

• Applicant (own income): € 15,000

• Each dependent child: € 8,000

Income within the meaning of the program includes, for example, income from own employment, maintenance payments from third parties (especially parents), other scholarships, etc.
