

KU scholarship 2023 for international students

In 2023, the KU offers a scholarship for academically **qualified international students** in need in order to promote internationalization at our University. This scholarship is funded by the Bavarian Ministry of Science and the Arts.

Funding term for summer: April 1, 2023 – August 31, 2023

Funding term for winter: October 1, 2023 – February 28, 2024

The stipend is expected to be **EUR 450.00 per month (i.e. EUR 2,250.00 in total)**, subject to the Ministry's funding commitment.

Prerequisites:

- Academic qualification
- Personal qualification
- You have not yet exceeded the maximum funding period (36 months) for this scholarship.
- You are enrolled as a student at the KU (campus Eichstätt or campus Ingolstadt) in an academic program during the funding period.
- Advanced studies with good study performance (undergraduates from 3rd semester onwards, graduates from 2nd semester onwards, PhD)
- o Financial need
- Excluded: students with a provisional admission, attending the DSH intensive German course, and free mover students
