



Call for applications PROMOS 2024

Funding for study trips abroad in 2024

PROMOS is a program to increase student mobility and replaces a number of DAAD scholarship programs. Unfortunately, these means are very limited due to cost-cutting measures.

Funding conditions

Funding can be granted for 1-2 study trips (of students) with a maximum duration of 12 days. The trip must be accompanied by at least one University representative. In addition to imparting subject-related knowledge and providing an insight into the host country, the **focus should be on meeting students and researchers**. Trips with a predominantly touristic program are not eligible for funding, nor are lecture or congress trips. The content of the trip should focus on **education**, **migration** and **sustainability**.

Aim of the funding

The aim of the funding for study trips is to increase the number of students who get the chance to travel abroad accompanied by a professor/lecturer during their studies.

The funding includes a per diem of € 45.00 or € 30.00 per person (depending on the destination country) for up to 12 students per trip with a maximum of 12 days of funding (total volume per trip thus € 6,480.00 or € 4,320.00). A maximum of one accompanying lecturer may also be funded at the above rates. Additional accompanying persons must be financed from other funds (e.g. faculty funds).

Application deadline

April 15th 2024

Required documents:

- 1) Detailed program description including schedule
- 2) Invitation letter from host university abroad
- 3) List of participants
- 4) Description of the content-related preparation of the participants (e.g. through obligatory attendance of a seminar)
- 5) Financing plan





Please note: PROMOS scholarships do not include any insurance coverage. However, sponsored students/doctoral candidates and accompanying University representatives have the opportunity to take out insurance through the DAAD.

After completion of the study trip:

Within one month after the end of the trip, the International Office must receive:

- 1) Report by the responsible lecturer(s) (accompanying person)
- 2) If applicable, reports in the press/media
