

How to use the eLearning Tool on Good Scientific Practice

How to properly document research results? How to quote properly? How to deal with image sources? The eLearning course "Good Academic Practice during Doctoral Studies" provided by Goethe University Frankfurt/M gives answers to all these questions both in German and English.

Follow these steps to access the eLearning Tool:

1. Register for the course „**Good Academic Practice during Doctoral Studies**“.

Afterwards you will receive a personal key for registration.



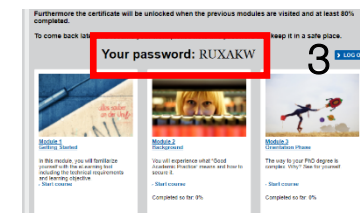
2. Follow the link to the **website of the Goethe University Frankfurt** https://www.uni-frankfurt.de/53981968/Gute_Wissenschaftliche_Praxis_in_der_Promotion and get registered.

NB Make sure to sign in with your full and proper name as this information will be used to generate your official KU certificate.
