### **Isaiah and the Twelve / Jesaja und die Zwölf**

#### **Tagungsort: Priesterseminar Collegium Willibaldinum, Leonrodplatz 3, Eichstätt**

Nach der Auftaktkonferenz über **"Voices of Israel: Isaiah and Micah" in Austin/Texas 2017** wird die **Forschungskooperation "Jesaja und Zwölfpropheten"** im Sommersemester 2018 mit einer Gegeneinladung nach Eichstätt fortgeführt. Im Rahmen einer **Konferenz vom 31. Mai bis 3. Juni 2018 über das Thema "ISAIAH AND THE TWELVE. Jesaja und die Zwölf"** wird ein erweiterter Kreis von Experten der Prophetie die **Beziehungen zwischen allen Textschichten des Jesajabuchs** einerseits und dem **gesamten Buch der zwölf sog. Kleinen Propheten** andererseits beleuchten. Ziel des Unternehmens ist es, erstmals einen ansatzweisen **Gesamtüberblick** über die komplexen Beziehungen zwischen Jesaja und dem Zwölfprophetenbuch und damit zusammenhängende theologische und historische Fragen zu erarbeiten. Die Ergebnisse sollen im Anschluss publiziert werden. Die Tagung wird durch die **Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (DFG)** gefördert.
